

**TARVISIO SUMMER TRAIL 2024 "á Malfi"**  
**RACE REGULATION**

**Art. 1 – Regulation acceptance**

The 4th edition of the Tarvisio Summer Trail "á Malfi" will take place on Saturday 14.09.24 at Lake Superior Fusine (UD), on the paths of the basin of the Lakes of Fusine and Monte Mangart.

The scheduled races are as follows:

- 1) Monte Mangart Summer Trail:** competitive race (route: 15.0 km with 920 m D+), reserved for those born from 31.12.2008. The ABSOLUTE ranking (M/F) will be drawn up as well as a ranking for the following categories (M/F):

- MASTER A: born from 1975 al 1984;
- MASTER B: born from 1965 to 1974;
- MASTER C: born before 1965.

- 2) Trail dei due Laghi:** non-competitive race, open to everybody (route: 10.0 km with 160 m D+).

Each participant must accept, in all its parts and without exceptions this regulation. Registering each participant agrees to accept the following Official Rules of the event and frees the organizers from any civil or penal liability for any accident, damage to persons or things to him and self-caused, that may occur before, during and after the event. Please note that the event takes place in alpine environment and therefore it is recommended to take all necessary safety measures.

**Art.2 – Organizing Committee**

The event is organized by the Sport Association "U.S. Mario Tosi Tarvisio" with the support of the Municipality of Tarvisio. The event is organized and named in memory of the late Mariano Malfitana, former President of the organizing company, athlete, ski instructor, coach, and organizer of many sporting events, including the Etna Marathon, the Tarvisio Winter Trail, the Alpine Relay of Mount Lussari and many others.

**Art.3 – Registration**

Registration online, no later than 11.09.24, as long as free starting places are available. Registration will be communicated via the "Tarvisio Trail Running" social channels. The registration fees have been fixed as follow:



**1) Monte Mangart Summer Trail** (route: 15.0 km with 920 m D+):

- Online within 31.07: 28.00 Euro;
- Online within 21.08: 33,00 Euro;
- Online within 11.09: 38,00 Euro;
- Euro 45,00 Euro for entries made up to one hour before the start of the race (subject to availability of race bibs).

**2) Trail dei due Laghi** (route: 10.0 km with 160 m D+):

- Online within 21.08: 20,00 Euro;
- Online within 11.09: 25,00 Euro;
- Euro 30,00 Euro for entries made up to one hour before the start of the race (subject to availability of race bibs).

The registration fee includes: race bib with timing chip, assistance and refreshments along the way, participation at the pasta-party, race pack with technical T-shirt, finisher medal.

The registration to the Monte Mangart Winter Trail must be accompanied by the documentation required in art. 4 penalty exclusion from participation in the event. The payment of the registration includes all the services described in this regulation. Each participant can verify the completion of the registration by visiting the website <https://www.tarvisiotrailing.com> and accessing the registration link. The registration will be considered completed only when the organizing company has received all the required documentation as indicated in art. 4 of this Regulation.

**Art. 4 - Admission of the participants**

**1) Monte Mangart Summer Trail** (route: 15.0 km with 920 m D+). To collect the bib and to be admitted to the race, the participants shall show to the race office followings:

- a) competitive **medical certificate** with the qualification for endurance sports (athletics, running, trail, cycling, cross-country skiing, ski mountaineering, etc.)
- b) CSI, FIDAL and MOUNTAIN & TRAIL RUNCARD or RUNCARD **membership cards** valid on day of the event. Anyone who does not have a membership card, will buy a membership card from U.S. Mario Tosi Tarvisio at an extra cost of 5,00 Euros. The card guarantees also the insurance coverage for the event.

**2) Trail dei due Laghi** (route: 10.0 km with 160 m D+). To collect the bib and to be admitted to the race, the participants shall NOT show any medical certificate. The membership card is optional. Anyone who wish, could buy it from U.S. Mario Tosi Tarvisio at an extra cost of 5,00 Euros. The membership card guarantees also the insurance coverage for the event.



3) The **registered** athlete who for his/her own reasons cannot participate in the race, will not have the possibility to postpone the registration for the 2025 edition, to transfer it to another athlete or to request a refund of the fee paid.

#### **Art. 5 – Rankings and prizes**

##### **1) Mount Mangart Summer Trail:**

- OVERALL ranking (M/F): from 1 to 5 classified technical articles and/or food and wine awards. The winner (M/F) will also be awarded with the 4th “Mariano Malfitano” trophy.
- MASTER A classification (M/F): from 1 to 3 classified technical articles and/or food and wine
- MASTER B classification (M/F): from 1 to 3 classified technical articles and/or food and wine
- MASTER C classification (M/F): from 1 to 3 classified technical articles and/or food and wine

The athlete belonging to one of the MASTER categories who is awarded at one of the prizes of the ABSOLUTE ranking, loses the right to the prize of his category.

2) **Trail dei due Laghi:** all participants will be given the finisher medal and the official event gadget

#### **Art. 6 – Bib and race pack delivery**

The delivery of the bibs will take place on the day of the event until 60 minutes before the scheduled time of departure at the race office set up on the race field (start-finish zone). The delivery of race-bibs will not take longer than the time indicated in this Regulation, so it is recommended to arrive at the departure in good time.

The obligatory equipment to be carried during the event will be checked at the entrance to the start-finish zone. Controls of the obligatory material will also be performed along the route and on arrival with disqualification in case of absence of the expected material.

Only athletes registered for the race who have regularly presented themselves and registered at the start will be entitled to collect the race pack. The race pack will be delivered at the end of the race, before the awards ceremony, upon presentation of the stamped starting bib.

#### **Art. 8 - Punching and checks at the start**

The bib must be pinned on the front, so that it is clearly visible, the chip must be worn and 30 minutes before the start the stamping will take place.

#### **Art. 9 – Checkpoints**



The checkpoints are distributed along the entire route and will have the task of recording the passage of the competitors and checking the mandatory material (randomly). The stamping carried out at the checkpoints will allow the arrival to establish the passage of the athletes. It is mandatory for the athletes to make sure that their passage has been recorded.

#### **Art. 10 – Give up**

In case of surrender, the competitor must compulsorily and as soon as possible inform the organization. The bib number will then be picked up at one of the checkpoints or refreshment points. Submitting its retire is very important to avoid that emergency rescues will be alerted in case of non-arrival of the athletes. It is compulsory that the athletes, who have decided to leave the race, do it at the checkpoints or refreshment points.

#### **Art. 11 - Location**

The description of the route in the latest version will be available on the website. The participants are invited to examine it carefully. Every change will be published on the website.

#### **Art. 12 - Security and medical assistance**

Safety and medical assistance will be guaranteed by the organization's staff spread on the route. The emergency vehicles will move along the track in the areas accessible to the vehicles in use. The managers on duty are authorized to stop the participants judged unfit to continue the event, in this case the bib will be withdrawn. Each athlete must, with penalty of disqualification, assist other athletes in need and to report to the organization's staff situations that require emergency rescues or help. Wheeler, emergency vehicles, vehicles of the organization and checkpoints are equipped with radios in permanent contact with the logistic base of the event. The competitor that calls a rescuer submits himself to his authority and undertakes to respect his decisions. The choice of the care and their nature will be left to the decision of the medical personnel. One or more organization volunteers will ensure the closure of the race and follow the last competitor. In any case, the race will be closed at the expiration of the maximal time set to pass the gate.

#### **Art. 13 – Insurance**

The organization will subscribe an insurance for civil liability for the entire duration of the event. The participation to the event is in any case under the entire responsibility of the competitors, who through their registration renounce at any recourse against the organizers for damages or other consequences that may happen to them during the event.

#### **Art. 14 - Refreshment points, food drinks**

2 refreshment points will be established along the route of Monte Mangart Summer Trail (Rifugio Zacchi and finish zone). Refreshment points will be provided with drinks and groceries.

#### **Art. 15 - Bags of competitors**

Service not provided.



#### **Art. 16 - Mandatory equipment**

- Use of trail running shoes;
- Long sleeve t-shirt and cap or bandana in case of adverse weather conditions.

In case of favorable weather conditions, the organizing committee may decide to remove the obligation to wear a long-sleeved shirt, cap or bandana, communicating this when the race bibs are handed out.

#### **Art. 17 - Maximum time**

The maximum race time for Monte Mangart Summer Trail is set at 3h00'. A gate will be set up / time will be indicated in the route description.

The organization staff will be adamant in blocking athletes who arrive at the gate outside the maximum time, this is to guarantee the safety of participants and volunteers on the route. A broom service is also planned that will run along the route following the last competitor, in order to be of assistance to those who have withdrawn and to avoid any injured people being left without assistance.

Please note that every athlete is required to ensure that their passage is recorded at each point of checking.

#### **Art. 18 - Penalties and disqualifications**

The organization's staff on the track is empowered to check the obligatory material and in general the respect of the entire Regulation. All the competitors, that at the time of the inspection on the track are found without the required materials will be immediately disqualified, without any possibility to avoid this sanction.

The organization may decide the disqualification of a competitor in the case of lack of respect of the Regulation and in particular:

- Bib or chip exchange;
- Missing a checkpoint;
- Route Cutting/shortening;
- Lack of part or all the required materials;
- Use of a vehicle;
- Departure from a checkpoint after the expiration of the time limit;
- Lack of assistance to another athlete in need;
- Leaving behind their own material on the path;
- Pollution or degradation of the place dropping trash on the track;
- Insults, rudeness or intimidations against organizers or volunteers;
- Avoid being examined by an organization rescuer at any time of the event;
- Physical and / or psychological estate considered unfit to continue

#### **Art. 19 - Complaints**

Any complaints must be submitted to the organization of the race within 30 minutes from the publication and posting of the Race-results. In accord with the spirit of the race, the organization trusts in the fair play of all the athletes.



#### **Art. 20 – Location/Track changes or cancellation of the event**

The organization reserves the right to change at any time the route or location of the places of control and refreshment, without any warning. In case of adverse weather conditions (cold, rain, high risk of thunderstorms or anything that in the opinion of the organization is dangerous for athletes), the departure can be postponed or cancelled, or the route can be modified and/or reduced.

In the event of adverse weather conditions involving safety reasons, the organization reserves the right to suspend the current event or change the time barriers.

In case of cancellation for reasons of force majeure, not attributable to the organization, 50% will be refunded of the fee paid, net of fees. This percentage is justified by the multiple expenditure which the Organisation has already carried out and which it cannot recover.

In case of interruption or cancellation of the race for weather reasons, or for any other cause independent of the Organization, no refund will be due to the participants.

In case of inability to participate in the race, you will be entitled to a refund of 60% of the registration fee only where the medical certificate is presented.

All refunds will be made within 60 days of the event ending.

#### **Art. 21 – Privacy, photo, television, video imaging rights**

The participant with the inscription authorizes the organization to the processing of personal data pursuant to the Decreto Legislativo 196/2003 “Codice in materia di protezione dei dati personali”(Italian Code regarding the protection of personal data). Each athlete participating may apply for cancellation of his/her data by sending a written request to the Sport Association Mario Tosi - Tarvisio.

Each participant expressly waives the right on his/her image during the race, as well as any claim against the organization and its partners enabled to use the image.

#### **Art. 22 - Declaration of Liability**

Participation in the TARVISIO SUMMER TRAIL means the acceptance in all its parts and without reserves, of this Regulation by the registered participant. Submitting the registration form, the participant declares to have read, understood and accepted in its entirety the present regulation of the event, waives the organization from any civil or criminal liability for damage to property and personal injuries caused in the context of the developing of the race and confirmed to be in possession of valid medical certificate to the event date of the event for sport competitive sports (athletics, particularly running) as in the 4<sup>th</sup> article of the present regulation. D.L. 196/03. Privacy policy: Personal data will be processed for the sole purpose of providing the service in question and will not be disclosed or used for other purposes.

#### **Art. 23 - Modifications to the Regulation**
